Welcome to the Autumn Term 2023

We enjoyed welcoming your children back yesterday. A warm welcome also to our new children and families joining us this term. I hope that you have all had a good summer break. We are very much looking forward to the term ahead.

Uniform

There was a change to our uniform policy in Sept 22 which was communicated to our official school shop. We requested clip-on and zip ties were no longer sold, as they often became faulty. However, it has come to our attention that Fashion Fair, an unofficial supplier, over the summer has sold zip and clip-on ties to families. I have spoken to the manager of Fashion Fair and they have agreed to exchange all zip and clip-on ties purchased at the store during the summer holidays, with a standard tie free of charge.
